Her research focuses on digital media, emotions and affect, datafication, migration, gender, race and ethnicity. Her current research projects investigate Intimacy in Data Driven Culture (IDA) and affective practices of online participation (HAFFECT). She has worked as a visiting professor at Karlstad University Sweden (2021-22), University of Massachusetts Amherst (2019), Microsoft Research Institute Cambridge (2019), London School of Economics (2017) Tulane University in New Orleans (2016), as a visiting scholar at Stanford University (2012) and in the School of Oriental and African Studies (SOAS) at the University of London (2009). She has published over 10 edited or authored volumes and over 100 articles in leading journals of media and communication research.
