Arrangements before leaving Finland: As a Ukrainian citizen, I am required to have a visa to visit

China. Two weeks before the study program started I had applied for a visa through the Chinese

visa center in Kyiv, Ukraine. For the visa application, I had to collect general documents,

invitation letter, tickets, and pay fee. I got the visa in 7 days after applying. Our plane tickets

were from Helsinki airport, so 28.07 I flew to Helsinki and on the same day, we had a plane to

Beijing.

Services provided by the organizing institution: After arrival to the Tsinghua University, we

registered as a student (received student card), moved in to the provided student

accommodation and get the instructions. Tsinghua University has covered fees for flight tickets,

part of the food spending in the university campus.

Accommodation: Student accommodation was provided by the Tsinghua University on the

territory of the University campus. It was an individual room for each student in the student

dormitory.

Studies: We had intensive two weeks of studying and competition work (preparing our prototype, presentations, and reports). The Study process was mostly in form of the workshops, lectures, and visiting the companies. After each day we supposed to write the reflection of the day from the team. On different stages, we had to make several presentations that reflected our progress. At the last day, we presented our project that is also a summary of our two week of work

Other topics of interest: During the trip, we had the opportunity to visit some historical destination in the Beijing and travel to the Great Chinese wall. Even though we have traveled a bit, we spent most of our time on the University campus. The campus has all needed facilities for students such as shops, canteens, pharmacy, and bank. The territory is equipped with sports fields and recreation zones.
