- Campus and the surrounding area constitute a major technology hub




Kauppi

- 244,000 inhabitants, the third largest city in Finland and the largest inland city in the Nordic countries
- The most attractive city in Finland

- 8,000 events and festivals each year
- The Sauna Capital of the World with over 30 public saunas!



Finland – the happiest country in the world

- 5,5 million 18,1 inhabitants per km² (46.6 per square mile)
- 338,440 km² (131,991 square miles) Western Europe's fifth-largest country
- Everyone has freedom to roam in the amazing natural environment: 188,000 lakes and 37 national parks
- The place to see Aurora Borealis, also known as the Northern Lights
- ... but no, we don't have polar bears



Cost of living

- Comparable to the rest of Northern
 Europe
- In addition to the rent, approximately 300–500 € per month covers food, transportation, personal and leisure expenses
- Meals at student restaurants are varied and lunch costs only about 3 €
