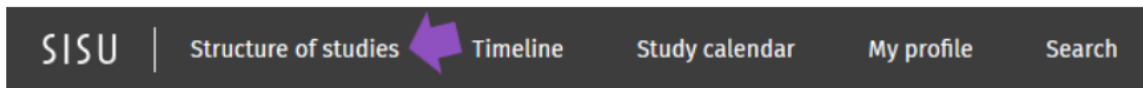


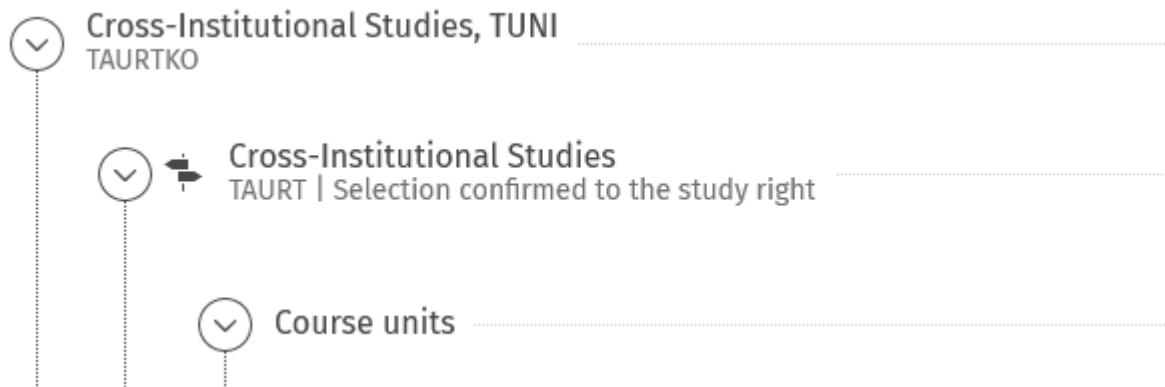
## Doing a PSP in Sisu – a quick guide for TAMK and POLAMK students

To be able to register for teaching, you must create a personal study plan in Sisu. The plan should include all the course units for which you have a study right and in which you wish to register. Create your PSP as follows:

1. Sign in to Sisu with your TUNI email address and password and go to the Structure of studies page:



2. If you do not have an existing study plan, a pop-up window to *Create a new study plan* opens. Check that you are in *My educations* and that you have ticked the box for *Cross-institutional study, TUNI*. The curriculum period and name of the study plan are created automatically, but you may also give the plan any name you choose. Finish by clicking the *Create a plan* button.
3. Continue by clicking the *Course units* headline, see the picture below:



4. A selection assistant will open on the right. Use the name or code to search for all the course units in which you have a right to study and add them to your plan, see the example below:



5. You have now created a study plan and added the course units in which you have a right to study.
