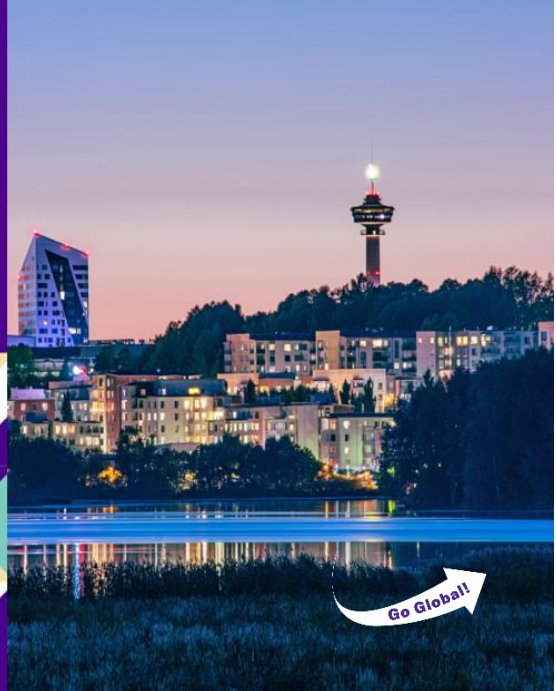

Campuses at Tampere University

Tampere University operates across three campuses in the city - the **City centre campus** hosts exchange students in fields such as humanities, business studies, educational sciences, psychology, political science, communication sciences, and social sciences. **Hervanta campus** is a major technology hub and the main base for natural sciences, engineering, architecture, computer sciences, and medical technology. **Kauppi campus**, located next to Tampere University Hospital, welcomes exchange students in medicine, biotechnology, and health sciences. All campuses are easily accessible by public transport, and it is possible to study on more than one campus if your schedule allows enough time for commuting between them. Language requirements

The required English proficiency level is **B2**. However, English language courses offered by the Faculty of Information Technology and Communication Sciences (ITC) are primarily intended for exchange students nominated for English language studies, and for these courses the required level is **C1**. English-taught courses and restrictions

Tampere University offers a wide range of study options for incoming exchange students. Applicants are required to submit a preliminary study plan based on the courses offered at the university, ensuring that the chosen study field aligns with their academic background at their home institution. Students may also select courses across different faculties, provided they meet the necessary prerequisites. Please note that access to certain fields, such as architecture, is limited to specific mobility agreements. Erasmus+ students are expected to choose most of their courses within the subject area specified in the bilateral agreement. For more details, see tuni.fi/tau-exchange.
