

Finland – the happiest country in the world for eight consecutive years

- Safe country with a population of 5,6 million (18,1 inhabitants per km² / 46,6 per square mile)
- Western Europe's fifth-largest country (area: 338,440 km² / 131,991 square miles)
- Everyone has freedom to roam in the amazing natural environment: 188,000 lakes and 41 national parks
- The place to see Aurora Borealis, also known as the Northern Lights (in Tampere as well)
- The land of highest coffee consumption per capita and crazy sports like swamp football and ice swimming
- ... but no, we don't have polar bears

Cost of living

- Comparable to the rest of Western Europe
- In addition to the rent, approximately 350–600 € per month covers food, transportation, personal and leisure expenses
- Meals at student restaurants are varied and inexpensive (about 3 €)
